

## Title: Scientist/Senior Scientist—Formulation Development

## **Job Summary:**

This is a laboratory-focused, experienced position within the Formulation Development Group at Concert Pharmaceuticals in Lexington, MA. The Scientist/Senior Scientist will be responsible for formulation development activities within one or more small-molecule development programs, including pre-formulation, process development, drug product characterization, and cGMP drug product manufacture. - Experience developing and utilizing analytical methods for drug product testing such as HPLC and dissolution
